Nurse Practitioner Practice Analysis

On February 22, 2016, the Canadian Council of Registered Nurse Regulators (CCRNR) released the findings of the Nurse Practitioner (NP) Practice Analysis. Conducted by CCRNR, the

analysis uncovered key information that will inform future regulatory decisions for NP practice across Canada.

The most significant findings from the NP Practice Analysis demonstrates that NPs across Canada use the same competencies in their practice in all Canadian jurisdictions and across the three streams of NP practice: family/all ages, adult and pediatrics.
