Because a spoken portion is not included, applicants must take a separate spoken English test.</p> <p>The TOEIC test is a paper-and-pencil, multiple-choice assessment that uses audiocassettes, pictures, and written materials to evaluate English language skills. It is broken down into two sections – listening and reading, and consists of 200 multiple choice questions. The test lasts approximately 2½ hours.</p> <p>Photo ID is required.
